3 28-03-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the respondents no. 2, 3 and 4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's case is squarely covered by an order of this Court dated 07.03.2018 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 9610 of 2017 (*Poonam Kumari & Ors. vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.*).

3. The petitioner is directed to file a detailed representation before the respondents no. 3 along with copy of order dated 07.03.2018 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 9610 of 2017 within a period of three weeks and the respondent no. 3 is well advised to consider the case of the petitioner after affording



opportunity of personal hearing or through his counsel and pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law within eight weeks thereafter.

4. It is made clear that the respondent no. 3 shall be liable for non-compliance of this order within the stipulated period.

5. With the aforesaid direction, the writ application stands disposed of.
