learned A.P.P. for the State along with learned counsel for the

O.P. No. 2.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case

registered for the offences punishable under Section 498A of the

Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel for the O.P. No. 2 submits that the mediation is

successful and the dispute in between the petitioner and the O.P.

No. 2 has been resolved, as such, it is submitted by the learned

counsel for the O.P. No. 2 that O.P. No. 2 does not have any

objection in the event if the present anticipatory bail application



is allowed.

4. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the O.P. No. 2, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Complaint Case No. C1-985 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.

5. Accordingly, the present anticipatory bail application stands allowed.
