- 3 26-04-2024 1. Heard learned counsel for the parties concerned.
2. The present petition has been filed for restoration of a criminal writ petition bearing Cr.W.J.C. no. 741 of 2022, which has stood dismissed on account of non compliance of the peremptory order dated 16.08.2023.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the



case was not marked, as such, defect could not be removed within time, granted by this Court, hence, a sympathetic view may be taken and the aforesaid criminal writ application be restored to its original file.
