2 17-02-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody in a
case registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that cash of Rs. 46,400/-, A.T.M.
Card, Mobile phone of the informant were robbed by
unknown criminals on gunpoint.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that petitioner is innocent and he has falsely
been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not named
in the F.I.R nor he was apprehended from the spot. The
petitioner has been roped in the present case only on the



self confession before the police which has no evidentiary value in the eye of law. Moreover, nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner and the petitioner has still not been put on T.I.P. The petitioner is languishing in custody since 13.10.2023.

In contra, learned A.P.P appearing on behalf of the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the period under custody, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-II, Rohtas at Sasaram in connection with Nokha P.S. Case No. 241 of 2023.
