2 17-02-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Bisfi (Patauna) P.S. Case No. 228 of 2023 registered for the
offence under Section 302, 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner is
said to have killed his wife.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. He further submits that the wife of the petitioner was
suffering from some illness and she was taken to the doctor for
the treatment of the same and in the post-mortem report also, it
has come that there is no ante-mortem injury on the body
deceased.



5. Learned counsel for the petitioner next submits that no cause of death has been mentioned in the post-mortem report and the doctor, while doing the post-mortem has found ECG lead over the chest and it appears that the deceased has sustained a Heart Attack and died because of the same.

6. It is also submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in jail since 23.08.2023.

7. Learned APP for the State vehemently opposed the prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts, this application is allowed.

9. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-I, Benipatti, Madhubani in connection with Bisfi (Patauna) P.S. Case No. 228 of 2023.
