ORAL ORDER

2 20-02-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 354(A) , 379, 504, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegedly, due to land dispute, all the accused persons including the petitioners are said to have assaulted the informant's side brutally with deadly weapons and petitioner no.2 tried to outrage the modesty of the informant's wife as well.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. No such occurrence as alleged ever took place.



Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case due to ulterior motive. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is admitted land dispute between the parties. There is case and counter case between them. Both sides have sustained grievous injury. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, as there is land dispute between the parties and both sides have sustained grievous injuries, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Bhairavasthan P.S. Case No. 100 of 2023, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
