APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Warisaliganj P.S. Case No. 566 of 2023 instituted for the offences under Section 420, 467, 468, 471, 120(B), 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 66(B), 66(D) of the Information Technology Act, 2000.

3. As per prosecution case, on receipt of information that some persons involved in cyber crime are trying to cheat the innocent persons in the name of advancing loan, the Informant along with other police personnel reached at the village Sonbarsa. On seeing the police-party, some persons started fleeing away but, on chase, seven of them were caught



including the present petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. He further submits that except one mobile, nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as has been stated in paragraph no.3 of the present bail application. The petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 09.11.2023.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner again points out that the co-accused Basant Kumar has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 19.02.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 8466 of 2024.

6. Per contra, learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case and taking into account the period of custody of the petitioner as also the petitioner having no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, abovenamed, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Warisaliganj P.S.
