This writ application has been filed for commanding the concerned respondent to allow the petitioner to appear in the counseling and further directing the respondent no. 8 to accept the joining of petitioner in the M.P. High School, Buxar, after her proper selection by the Bihar Public Service Commission (for



short “B.P.S.C.”), pursuant to Advertisement No. - 26/2023, alongwith corrigendum letter dated 27.06.2023.

2. At the outset, by referring to paragraph 7 of the counter affidavit filed on behalf of Respondent no. 3, learned State counsel submits that petitioner does not have requisite qualification for appointment as Computer Teacher in Higher Secondary School. Learned State counsel next submits that for appointment of Primary Teacher, Secondary Teacher and Higher Secondary Teacher, the candidate must have passed S.T.E.T. Paper – II examination, but the petitioner does not have requisite qualification and as such, she was not allowed to join.

3. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the writ petition stands dismissed.
