seeking the following relief:-

*"(i) For issuance of a writ in the nature of
Certiorari to quash order dated 2.12.2021
passed in ICDS Appeal Case No.71/2020 by
the learned Commissioner, Tirhut Division,
Muzaffarpur whereby and whereunder the
order of District Programme Officer has been
set aside and ordered to conduct fresh
appointment under the Rule though the
petitioner is selected on the post of*

*ii) For issuance of a writ in the nature of
Mandamus directing and commanding to the
Respondent to not disturb the petitioner till
adjudication of the application. Present"*
