learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Mahila P.S. Case No.37/2023 registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 341, 323, 504, 506, 498(A) and 34 of
the Indian Penal Code, pending in the court of learned SDJM,
Bhojpur at Ara.

3. The learned APP at the outset submits that the
offence for which the instant F.I.R. has been instituted against
the petitioner carries a punishment of less than 7 years to which
the learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute.

No.3536/2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. State of Bihar) and the Superintendent of Police shall ensure that Investigating Officer of the case strictly adhere to the direction contained in the said order.
