learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Bhairavsthan P.S. Case No. 23 of 2023 registered for the offence
under Sections 399, 402, 414 of the Indian Penal Code and
under Section 25(1-b)a, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, one country made
pistol has been recovered from the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in
this case. He further submits that other co-accused persons have
been granted bail from this Court.

5. It is also submitted by the learned counsel for the



petitioner that the petitioner is in jail since 10.02.2023.

6. Learned APP for the State vehemently opposed the prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail by contending that the petitioner is accused in five more cases of similar and serious nature.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and the antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Accordingly, this application is dismissed.

9. The trial Court is directed to expedite the trial of the petitioner and if there is no sufficient progress in the trial due to the fault of the prosecution then the petitioner may renew his prayer for grant of bail.
