2. On 24.06.2024, following order was passed :

“The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner has died during the pendency of the present petition and legal heirs/representatives of the petitioner may file appropriate application.

2. List the matter on 21.10.2024 under the appropriate heading”.

3. Thereafter, on 21.10.2024, following order was passed :
