3 29-01-2024 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State along with learned counsel for the O.P. No. 2.

2. The learned counsel for the O.P. No. 2 submits that in the present quashing application, the order of cognizance is under challenge, when even the discharge application of the petitioners herein has been rejected by the learned Trial court. It
