2 29-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"a. To direct the respondents to remove, the remaining encroachment on public road appertaining to Khata No-424, Survey Plot No-548 Area-58 decimal (12 Kattha 18 Dhur), situated at Mauza - Mahna Thana No 350, P.S- Bhagwanpur Hatt,Sub-Division Mahrajganj, District - Siwan

b. To direct the respondents to hold an enquiry with regards to non-removal of



complete encroachment in Encroachment Case No-02/2023-24 initiated by Circle Officer, Bhagwanpur Hatt, Mahrajganj, District-Siwan wherein only eye wash of removing encroachment has been done in the light of order dated 24/08/2023 passed in CWJC No- 5383/2023 passed by this Hon'ble court however, the encroachment is still existing."

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent no.6, i.e. the Circle Officer, Bhagwanpur Hatt, District-Siwan for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
