“1(a) In the nature of Mandamus for directing and commanding the respondents to consider the case of the Petitioner for appointment on the post of Constable pursuance to the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of W.P.(Civil) No.: 1133/2019 Manjesh Kumar and Others Vs.
