2 27-02-2024 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Karakat P.S. Case No.262/2023 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Amendment Act, 2018.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and allegation is of
recovery of 105 litres of liquor from a place near a high school.
It is next submitted that petitioner was not arrested from the spot
as such nothing was recovered from his conscious possession
and even alleged recovery is from a place which is accessible to
public at large and he came to be implicated at the instance of



local villagers but then the name of villagers, who disclosed the name of the petitioner is not disclosed in the F.I.R., which casts an aspersion on the case of the prosecution.

4. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

5. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise-I, Rohtas, Sasaram, in connection with Karakat P.S. Case No.262/2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
