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| 2 | 02-05-2024 | 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):- |
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“1. That this is an application on behalf of the petitioner for issuance a writ, order or direction including a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondent No. 1 to 4 to take appropriate action against the encroacher related to the land mentioned in the Encroachment case No. 24 of 2022-23 and directed to the respondent no. 4 removed the encroached the land recorded as a Anabad Sarvsadharan in the village- Abhaide, P.S. Ramgarh, district-Kaimur at Bhabua and may be directed to the concern respondent to remove the construction in public land (Anabad Sarv Sadharan) and issuance a writ order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents to not construct any type of hut in the



future in the public land.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks a direction upon the Circle Officer, Ramgarh, District-Kaimur at Bhabhua, to conclude the proceedings of the pending Encroachment Case No.24 of 2023-24.

3. The learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case the aforesaid encroachment case is still pending adjudication, the same would definitely be disposed off, within a stipulated time frame, as is fixed by this Court.

4. Having regard to the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, I deem it fit and proper to direct the Circle Officer, Ramgarh, District-Kaimur at Bhabhua, to conclude the proceedings of the aforesaid Encroachment Case No.24 of 2023-24, by passing the final order under Section 6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, in accordance with law and after hearing the affected parties, within a period of 6 weeks of receipt/production of a copy of this order

5. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
