S.D. Sanjay, who has appeared through virtual mode and
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Saharsa
Sadar P.S. Case No. 520 of 2022 registered for the offence under
Section 489A, 489B and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, out of Rs.
8,56,483/- deposited by the petitioner in the Kachahari Branch,
SBI, Saharsa it is alleged that currency notes amounting to Rs.
2,74,000/- are fake notes.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in
this case.



5. It is also submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in jail since 07.10.2023.

6. Learned APP for the State vehemently opposed the prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail by contending that this is serious offence and the petitioner is the person who has deposited the fake notes in the bank.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Accordingly, this application is dismissed.

9. The trial Court is directed to expedite the trial of the petitioner and conclude the same at the earliest. If there is no sufficient progress in the trial due to the fault of the prosecution side then the petitioner may renew his prayer for grant of bail.
