seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this writ petition is for issuance of a writ of mandamus direction / commanding the respondents to provide protection from the private respondent in proper utilization of land bearing Khata No. 120 Plot No. 770, Area 0.5 Decimal situated in Village - Mohiuddinpur, P.S.
