ORAL ORDER

2 13-05-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

"1(i) For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for commanding and directing the respondent authorities concerned to cancel the Parcha issued for



Bhind of pond and remove the encroachment from the land of Baba Bal Nath Mandir, Chitakhal, Police Station+ Anchal-Guthani, District-Siwan appertaining to Thana no.82 Khata No.452 Survey No.541, 453, 617, 539, 587, 614 and khata no.451 survey no.1010 situated in village- Chitakhal, Police Station+ Anchal-Guthani, District-Siwan, which has been illegally encroached by some anti-social elements.

(ii) For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for commanding and directing the respondent authorities concerned to dispose off the representation filed by the petitioner with reasoned and speaking order, but the same is still pending.

(iii) For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for commanding and directing the respondent authorities concerned to comply the order dated 16.06.2023 passed by the District Magistrate cum Second Appellate Authority, Siwan."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent no.06, i.e. the Circle Officer, Guthani, District-Siwan for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so



sought, is granted.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed off.
