2      29-02-2024              The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That by this writ application, the petitioner seeks indulgence of this Hon'ble court for issuance of an appropriate writ or direction to the respondents to consider and grant promotion on the post of lower division clerk with all



consequential benefits of service, when junior persons to the petitioner namely Prashant Kumar Sinha, Vikki Kumar and Diwyanshu Kumar having been granted promotion on the post of lower division clerk.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the Superintending Engineer, Public Health Mechanical Circle, Bhagalpur, i.e. the Respondent No. 4, for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
