2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
retiral dues of the petitioner has not been granted. Besides the
above, amount of Provident Fund, Group Insurance, Gratuity,
leave Encashment and due salary have also been demanded, but
even after the representation filed by the petitioner, nothing has
been paid to him.

3. Learned counsel for Co-operative Land
Development Bank, Bihar, Patna on the other hand, submits that
this petition is not maintainable.
