2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in connection with Bahadurpur
P.S. Case No. 546 of 2019 registered for the offences punishable
under Section 363 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The learned APP for the State submits that the
offence for which the instant FIR has been instituted against the
petitioner carries punishment of seven years, the said
submission of the learned APP is not disputed by the learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.
