"1. That this is an application for direction or directions, order or orders by way of an appropriate writ



or writs preferably in the nature of Mandamus, commanding and directing the respondents to appoint the petitioner as casual labour, as in identical matters department has considered the name of similarly situated employee (private respondents no-9 and 10), who has been serving department continuously since long. Further, directing and commanding the respondents to abide by the order passed in review petition by the Central Administrative Tribunal in R.A. No.- 06/2021 dated 10.07.2008."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner shall approach the learned Central Administrative Tribunal, Patna for redressal of his aforesaid grievances.
