3 19-02-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*"1. That the present writ application is being
filed for issuance of appropriate writ/writs,
direction/directions for appointing the
petitioner on the post of "SWACHCHHATA
PARYAWEKSHAK as he is having all the
essential qualification and experiences for
that but due to malafide intention he has not*



been selected by the Mukhiya and Panchayat Secretary of Gram Panchayat, Thengha, Tardih, Darbhanga who recommended the name of one Sunil Yadav for oblique reasons though the said Sunil Yadav is not having essential qualification as well as experience for the post and/or for any other relief or reliefs to which the petitioner may be found entitled to in course of hearing of this writ application."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a civil suit before the learned civil court of competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
