2 01-03-2024 1 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2 The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case regis-
tered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323,
307/34 of the IPC and Section 30(a)/45 of the Bihar Excise Act.

3 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has antecedent of one case and allegation is of recov-
ery of 54.220 litres of liquor from a gunny bag loaded on motor-
cycle.

4 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner was not arrested from the spot as such nothing was re-
covered from his conscious possession and is not owner of the
seized motorcycle and he came to be implicated at the instance
of a local *Chowkidar* with whom he is on an inimical term.



5 Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

6 Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Barauli P.S. Case No. 380 of 2023 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
