2 22-02-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 307, 354, 379,34 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, petitioner tried to outrage modesty of the informant and on protest, petitioner and other accused persons assaulted the informant and her family members.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that as a matter of fact scuffle took place between the parties over flowing of Tank water in front of the house under the Nal Jal Scheme in which both sides sustained injuries. There is case and counter case. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Considering the aforesaid facts of the case, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. In the event of



arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner, mentioned above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate 1st class cum Additional Munsif, Samastipur in Kalyanpur Police Station Case No. 219 of 2023, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
