learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Bidupur P.S. Case No. 170 of 2018 for the offences
punishable under Sections 406, 408, 471, 420 and 34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

3. The learned APP submits that the offence for which
the instant FIR has been instituted, carries punishment of seven
years or less, the said submission of the learned APP is not
disputed by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner.

4. In view of the submission made by the learned
APP, the anticipatory bail application is disposed of in terms of
the order dated 13-2-2024 passed in Criminal Miscellaneous
