2 08-08-2024 Heard Dr. Manoj Kumar, learned Advocate for the petitioner and Mr. Manoj Kumar Sinha, learned Advocate for the State.

2. The petitioner by invoking the extraordinary jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a direction upon respondent No.3, the learned Additional Collector, Land Ceiling, Bhagalpur to dispose off the Land Ceiling Case Appeal No.67/1984-85 expeditiously as the same is pending since 2010.

3. Considering the limited grievance of the petitioner, this Court deems it fit and proper to dispose off the writ petition with a direction to respondent No.3 to take up the Land Ceiling



Case Appeal No.67/1984-85 and bring it to its original conclusion preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt /production of a copy of this order.

4. Suffice it to say that before disposal of the aforementioned case, it is expected that a fresh notice be given to all the stakeholders.

5. Accordingly the present writ petition stands dismissed.
