2. The present matter has been taken out of turn as per

appropriate forum and avail remedy under Section 3G(5) of the

National Highways Act, 1956.

3. It goes without saying that if the petitioner

approaches the appropriate forum for redressal of his grievance,



the same shall be considered taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner was pursuing the matter before this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, since the matter was pending since 2021.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction given to the petitioner to approach the competent authority as prescribed under Section 3G(5) of the National Highways Act, 1956.
