Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Laheri P.S Case No. 92/2023 dated 07.02.2023 registered for the offence punishable u/s 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, unknown miscreant is alleged to have stolen the motorcycle of the informant which was parked near his door.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner has two criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is not named in the



F.I.R. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the nature of allegation against the petitioner, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned, Nalanda at Biharsharif in connection with Laheri P.S Case No. 92/2023, subject to conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

7. The application stands allowed.
