9 19-07-2024 From perusal of the record, it is evident that limited direction of the co-ordinate Bench is to consider the petitioners’ representation by the concerned authority. The official respondents made various correspondences and ultimately passed an order of compliance in the month of April, 2024.

2. Accordingly, the present contempt proceeding stands dropped reserving liberty to the petitioners to approach the concerned authority if he has still grievance to be redressed.

3. Imposition of cost on previous occasion has not been paid by the State to the petitioners. The same shall be paid during course of the day, failing which further cost of Rs. 5,000/- is imposed for violation of the order of this Court.
