2 14-03-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1. That, this is an application for issuance of an appropriate writ order or direction for quashing order no.-1.12015/A(Discp)/NA B.K. Pandey- 28AR/18/9215 at 06-12-2018 issued by Lt. Col, SOI (A) Directorate General Assam Rifles Shillong-10 i.e. Annexure- 9 where by mercy appeal filed by the petitioner to reinstate him in service has been rejected which is illegal and for a direction to the respondents to treat the petitioner reinstated in service w-e-f 12-12-2003 and grant him his back wages and pension etc as he has already attained his age of



*superannuation or for any other order or orders
which this Hon'ble may deem fit and proper
under the circumstances of this case.”*

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner shall approach the appropriate forum/Court of Law of competent jurisdiction for redressal of his aforesaid grievances.
