ORAL ORDER

6 25-11-2024 1. On 25.06.2024, the Learned counsel for the petitioner reported to the Court that the file is missing, therefore, sought for an adjournment. On 26.07.2024, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and the matter was directed to be listed as a last indulgence. On 07.10.2024, inspite of matter being



posted as a last indulgence, the Learned counsel for the petitioner again sought for an adjournment and this Court has adjourned the matter on payment of cost of Rs. 500/- to the Bihar State Legal Services Authority and directed the matter to be listed for today i.e. on 25.11.2024.
