4 22-10-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1(i) For issuance of an appropriate writ(s), order(s), direction to the respondents for payment of adequate compensation to the petitioner for the custodial death of the petitioner's mother Bibi Sakina Khatoon.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative
