3 18-04-2024 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 364(A), 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the FIR, the petitioner is said to have kidnapped the informant with an intention of demand for ransom. When the family members of the informant went to the place of occurrence, the petitioner escaped from there.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. There is no specific overt act against the petitioner. He further submits that the



occurrence took place on 11.09.2023 and the FIR was lodged on 13.09.2023 i.e. after a delay of two days, without giving any plausible explanation regarding the said delay which creates a doubt over the prosecution story. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Laxmipur (Gidhour) P.S. Case No.415 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
