ORAL ORDER

2 23-02-2024 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Excise P.S. Case No.-2145 of 2023 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 30(a) and 32(b) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act, 2018.

3. As per allegation in the FIR, total 134.280 liters of foreign liquor was recovered from the middle side of dickeys of the car.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this and he has no concern with the alleged recovery and nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of



the petitioner. He next submits that on perusal of seizure list there was no independent witness. Petitioner has got clean antecedent as stated in para-3 of the petition and he is in custody since 17.12.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State, opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances and alleged liquor has not been recovered from the conscious physical possession of this petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail *after framing of the charge* in connection with Excise P.S. Case No.2145 of 2023 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Excise Court No.III, Gaya.

7. The trial court is directed to conclude the proceeding of framing of charge according to law within a period of 15 (fifteen) days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. However, it is made clear that *if the charge-sheet has not been submitted* then the above named petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond with further condition that the petitioner have to present physically on each and every date before the Trial Court till conclusion of the proceeding of framing of



charge.
