ORAL ORDER

2 04-03-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Manjhi
P.S. Case No. 168 of 2023 instituted for the offence under
Sections 302, 120(B) & 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section
27 of the Arms Act.

3. Prosecution case in a nutshell is that father of the
informant was shot dead while they were returning from
wedding ceremony.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 08-09-2023. Petitioner is
stated to be man of clean antecedent.

5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's
counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present



case. Petitioner is not named in the FIR. Name of the petitioner has surfaced in this case due to confessional statement of co-accused, namely, Ravi Kumar @ Ravi Kumar Yadav, who has been granted bail by the Court below itself. There is no specific allegation attributed to the petitioner. Specific allegation is against Nautanki Singh and Gadar Singh Charge sheet has already been submitted in this case.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioner, clean antecedent of the petitioner and no direct allegation against the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Manjhi P.S. Case No. 168 of 2023.
