2 06-05-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief(s):-

*“1. (A) For issuance of a writ in appropriate nature
of Mandamus directing and commanding the
Commissioner, Darbhanga Division, Darbhanga to
dispose of Miscellaneous Stamp Deficit Appeal Case
No. 15/2021 which is pending before the
Commissioner for long time.*

*(B) For further direction to the respondent authorities
Sub Registrar, Registration to hear a fresh after
giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.*

*(C) For further quashing of the order dated
31.08.2021 passed by the Assistant Registration
Registrar, Darbhanga in Stamp Case No. 4/2021-22
whereby the Stamp case was allowed directing the
petitioner to deposit the deficit stamp of Rs.
3,81,546/- within 60 days, otherwise the petitioner*



would have to pay the aforesaid amount along with 5% interest till deposit of the said amount as the order was passed without hearing of the petitioner.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks a direction upon the Commissioner, Darbhanga Division, Darbhanga, to dispose off the Miscellaneous Stamp Deficit Appeal Case No.15 of 2021, within a stipulated time frame.

3. Per contra, the learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case the aforesaid case is still pending adjudication, the same would definitely be disposed off, within a stipulated time frame, as is fixed by this Court.

4. Having regard to the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, I deem it fit and proper to direct the Commissioner, Darbhanga Division, Darbhanga, to dispose off the aforesaid Miscellaneous Stamp Deficit Appeal Case No.15 of 2021, by passing a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of 8 weeks of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

5. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
