3 19-04-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned A.P.P. on behalf of the State.

The instant application for regular bail has been

filed by the petitioner in connection with Shastri Nagar P.S.

Case No. 422 of 2023 instituted for the offence punishable

under Sections 379 of Indian Penal code.

Earlier the application for regular bail of the

petitioner was rejected by order dated 21.09.2023 passed in

Cr. Misc. No. 55235 of 2023 with an observation to learned

trial court to expedite the trial and conclude the same as

soon as possible.

In pursuance to the direction of this Court, a report



with regard to present stage of trial dated 20.03.2024 has been received and the same is kept at flag 'C'. From its perusal it appears that the trial will be concluded probably within one year.

No fresh ground is made for reconsideration of the regular bail of the petitioner. Accordingly, prayer for grant of regular bail is rejected.

Accordingly, petition stands disposed off.

However, learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial within a period of six months, failing which, the petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer of bail.
