2 06-05-2024 The present writ has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. For direction upon the Respondents to take immediate and appropriate action, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and personal property of the Petitioner is protected from the Private Respondent No.8 & 9, who being an anti-social element is harassing the Petitioner and are trying to occupy the possession of the Petitioner's



property which is situated next to the Private Respondent in connivance with the State Respondents in view of the representation/application made to the Authorities (Respondent No.1 to 7) from time to time in this behalf as well as the law settled by the Hon'ble Court in an identical matter contained in Order dated 11.1.2013 passed in CWJC No. 530 of 2013.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the District Magistrate, Katihar, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
