5 26-02-2024 Heard Mr. Vijay Shankar Shrivastava, learned Counsel for the petitioners in C.W.J.C. No. 2855 of 2023 and C.W.J.C. No. 5286 of 2023, Mr. Nitesh Kumar, learned Counsel for the petitioner in C.W.J.C. No. 7801 of 2023 and learned Assistant Counsels to S.C.-25, A.A.G.-12 and G.P.-18.
