- 3 24-06-2024 1. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned APP for the State Mr. Ravindra Kumar.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in connection with Koilwar P.S. Case No.512/2023, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379, 411, 34 of the Indian Penal Code & Sections 11/56 BM(CPIMTS) Amendment Rules 2021 and Sections 3/4 of MMDR Act, 1957. It is next submitted that the investigation in the case is still pending.
3. The learned APP at the outset submits that the offences for which the instant F.I.R. has been instituted against the petitioner carries a punishment of 7 years and less to which the learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute.
4. In view of the submission made by the learned APP



the anticipatory bail application is disposed of in terms of the order dated 13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No.3536/2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. State of Bihar).

5. The petitioner would be at liberty to file a representation within a period of three weeks from today before the concerned Superintendent of Police of the district and the Investigating Officer of the case with a web copy of the order dated 13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No.3536/2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. State of Bihar) and the Superintendent of Police shall ensure that Investigating Officer of the case strictly adhere to the direction contained in the said order.
