1(i). For issuance of an appropriate writ directing the respondents for removal of the land bearing Khata No. 47 plot No. 1332 in Mauja Baijnathpatti, Tauji No. 5026, Thana No. 184



Anchal Sattar Kataiya District - Saharsa from the Restriction Register (Rock Suchi) of Registration Department of Government of Bihar.

(ii). For direction upon the respondents to register the sale deed as contained in Annexure -1 executed by the petitioners in favour of Respondent No. 9, 10 as there is no dispute in the land.”

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present writ petition, to which the learned counsel appearing for the State has got no objection.
