4 04-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1(a). For a direction upon the Respondents to pay a sum of Rs. 4, 00, 000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs) to the Petitioner as Ex-Gratia Grant in view of the fact that the mother of the Petitioner (Late Renu Kumari) passed away while working as Anganwadi Sevika forthwith with penal interest for unreasonable and unnecessary delay in the payment.”
