3 27-09-2024 Heard Mrs. Patla Kumari, learned counsel for the petitioner and no one appears on behalf of the State.

2. The present petition has been filed to initiate contempt proceeding against the contemnor against the order 30.08.2019 passed in CWJC No. 17754 of 2019.

3. A show cause has come on behalf of the opposite party nos. 4 to 6 annexing Annexure-A which is the order passed



by the Circle Officer, Chhatapur, Supaul in Miscellaneous Case No. 09 of 2017-18 according to which, the claim of the petitioner stands rejected for vide an order dated 24.02.2020.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a copy was served only yesterday and then they came to know about the rejection. Further submission is that she may granted permission to challenge the order.
