2. The petitioners have prayed for the following
reliefs:

(i) for issuance of a writ in the nature
of certiorari *quashing the judgment*
dated 29.1.2024 passed by Hon'ble
Member (Judicial) Bihar Land
Tribunal, Patna in B.L.T. Case
No.418 of 2022 whereby case filed by
the petitioners has been dismissed;

(ii) for setting aside the order dated
6.3.2022 *passed by Additional*
Collector, Gaya in Mutation Revision
Case No.75/2017-18 by which he has
dismissed the revision and affirmed
the order dated 22.9.2017 passed by
the learned D.C.L.R. Sherghati in
Mutation Appeal No.30 of 2017-18
whereby and whereunder the DCLR
Sherghati affirmed the order dated
21.11.2012 passed by Circle Officer,

(iii) for grant of any other
relief/reliefs for which the petitioners
is legally entitled in the facts and
circumstances of the case.*
