ORAL ORDER

2 04-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1(i). That an appropriate writ may be issued commanding upon the respondents concerned to absorb the petitioners in the Animal Husbandry Department having experience of private animal vaccination worker since a long period, all of the petitioners are serving their duties at the rate of Rs. 4/ to 9/- rupees per vaccination of animal which is lowest payment to service.”



2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the Respondents authorities for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
