“1(i). To issue writ/writs in the nature of mandamus for directing the Respondents to pass an order for removing the encroachment made over the Bandobasti land, situated at Mauza Baghari Bazar, Thana No.78, Khesra No. 14661 and 14647, Area 5.10 Decimal and 0.05 decimal, Thana & Circle Runisaidpur and the Bandobasti land situated at Mauza Manik Chowk, Thana No. 72,
