2. Petitioners apprehend arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 363, 365/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, daughter of the informant got married with petitioner No. 1 and thereafter, all the accused persons including these petitioners used to torture and harass her for dowry for which she lodged a case *vide* Palasi P. S. Case No. 321/18 due to which the accused persons, in



connivance with others, abused and assaulted her and then kidnapped her and took her away and when she tried to restrain them, all the accused persons threatened to kill her.

4. Considering the nature of accusation, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is refused.
